Board Appoints Quattrocki after Interim Leadership

BALTIMORE (June 25, 2014) — The Board of Trustees of the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange has confirmed the appointment of Carolyn Quattrocki as executive director for a term of one year.

Ms. Quattrocki has served as interim executive director of the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange since she was appointed by the Board on Dec. 6.

“I look forward to a tremendous year. I also want to thank the Board and MHBE staff for their incredible hard work, and all our stakeholders who have been so supportive of us,” Ms. Quattrocki told the Board on June 24 after accepting the position.

Ms. Quattrocki previously served as executive director of the Governor’s Office of Health Care Reform. Ms. Quattrocki also worked as a Special Assistant to Maryland Attorney General J. Joseph Curran Jr., and was a litigation associate at the law firm of Arnold & Porter in Washington, D.C. She also served as a law clerk for the Honorable Frank A. Kaufman, Chief Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Maryland.

Ms. Quattrocki has a law degree from Yale University and a Bachelor of Arts from Northwestern University.
